Catch OU spirit at WOCOU 2002

Do you have it? If you don't, chances are you'll catch it during The Spirit of WOCOU (Week of Champions @ Oakland University) 2002. What is it? OU spirit, of course.

OU spirit will be contagious during a jam-packed week of events leading up to OU's fourth annual Midnight Madness, when the men's and women's basketball teams kick off the 2002-2003 NCAA Division I basketball season.

WOCOU is OU's answer to homecoming, without the football.

"WOCOU helps us unify the OU community, provides a sense of identity and recognizes all of our champions – OU students, faculty, staff and alumni," said Jean Ann Miller, director of the Center for Student Activities. "Every year, WOCOU attracts more attention and participation. We strive to make it better every year, and it is, because of OU spirit."

The celebration begins Monday, Oct. 7, at noon in the Oakland Center Fireside Lounge, with entertainment by the OU African Ensemble "Akwaaba" and Steel Band "Pan Jumbies" and free "Grizztracks" ice cream cones and WOCOU T-shirts.

The honorary chairperson for WOCOU 2002 is OU alumnus Steve Blackwood, star of NBC's "Days of Our Lives." He will make a special guest appearance Thursday, Oct. 10, at noon in the Oakland Center Fireside Lounge to talk about his career as a soap opera actor.

"We're excited to bring back a famous alumnus to inspire students and show them what they can achieve after completing their education at OU," Miller said.

Blackwood, also a talented jazz musician, will be a special guest performer at the Association of Black Students (ABS) and Student Program Board (SPB) Talent Show Thursday, Oct. 10, at 8 p.m. in the Oakland Center Pioneer Food Court.

Show Your OU Spirit Day is Friday, Oct. 11, with the University Appreciation Dinner from 5 - 7 p.m. in the Oakland Center Pioneer Food Court. OU students, faculty and staff are invited to attend. The grizzly-inspired dinner will include bear cookies, black forest cupcakes, and a sticks and berries snack complementing the main course of apple wood-smoked turkey with dried fruit and sage dressing.

OU faculty and staff tickets for the University Appreciation Dinner can be requested by contacting Miller at **jam@oakland.edu**. Students can pick up their tickets at the **CSA Service Window**.

The campus will be hopping with other activities on Friday, Oct. 11, including a comedian/magician after the appreciation dinner, an open house at the Recreation and Athletics Center, and the Student Athletes Advisory Council Bonfire. It's OU students versus OU faculty and staff in a friendly game of basketball at 10:30 p.m. at the Athletics Center O'Rena.

Midnight Madness begins when the men's and women's basketball teams take to the court at 11 p.m. There's also a laser light show and an OU spirit contest. Contest winners will be drawn for the Great Golden Grizzly \$100 giveaway, compliments of the Office of Student Affairs, and two winter semester 2003 tuition scholarships, compliments of the Office of the President.
