BAND CONCERT TONIGHT

The Oakland University Concert Band will present a joint concert at 8 p.m. today (Monday) with the band from the University of Michigan Flint Campus. The free concert will be held in the recital hall of the Performing Arts Building. Each band will perform several selections separately. Then they will combine to perform four numbers in a massed band of about 80 players. The program will include music by Richard Strauss, Alfred Reed, Alberto Ginastera, Vincent Persichetti, Henry Fillmore, and Clifton Williams. The program will be repeated Wednesday evening at the Flint Campus.

STUDENTS DISPLAY ART

The Senior Art Show, a special exhibit featuring a new medium known as "environmental art," will be held this week in the University Art Gallery in Wilson Hall.
