

Grizz Facts: A look at institutional aid

In 2017, beyond Federal and State aid, Oakland University awarded more than \$15 million in institutional aid (grants and scholarships) to full-time freshmen alone. Among their peers at other public universities in Michigan, OU freshmen receive some of the largest institutional aid packages. Institutional aid was offered to 85 percent of freshman students entering during 2017 and averaged \$7,478, which equates to more than half the cost of full-time tuition.
