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Undergraduate Publishes Paper as Part of an REU Program

The **National Science Foundation** supports "**Research Experiences for Undergraduate**" (REU) programs at universities throughout the United States. Oakland has run several such programs, including the **Summer Materials Research Training** (SMaRT) program in the **Department of Physics**. Outstanding undergraduates participate in these programs, to the benefit of both the student and their faculty mentor. In the June 2009 issue of **Medical & Biological Engineering & Computing**, CBR member Brad Roth and undergraduate Kevin Schalte published the results of their research as part of the SMaRT program (**Ultrasonically-Induced Lorentz Force Tomography**, Volume 47, Pages 573-577). Their study provides a new method to image electrically conductivity in biological tissue.
