OU hosting meetings on Master of Arts in Teaching

Oakland University's **School of Education and Human Services** (SEHS) will host informational meetings about its Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) with initial secondary teacher certification program. The meetings are Tuesday, March 4, at 5 p.m. at the Macomb Intermediate School District (MISD) in Clinton Township and on Thursday, March 6, at 6 p.m. at Andover High School in Bloomfield Hills.

Developed to address Michigan's shortage of qualified teachers at the secondary level, OU's MAT program is a teacher certification program aimed at career changers. Courses are scheduled in the evening and on weekends, with the exception of student teaching.

The Oakland County MAT program is offered in partnership with the Bloomfield Hills School District. A second cohort start is planned for the fall 2003 semester at the MISD. Applications currently are being accepted for both programs.
