1982 OUTLOOK

After two consecutive near misses for an NCAA Division II tournament playoff bid, the Oakland Pioneer soccer team believes this could be their year. The 1981 team finished their season with four straight wins and an overall season record of 14-4-1 (best record since 1973), but were unable to secure a playoff spot.

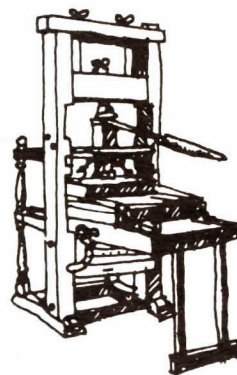
The 1982 team includes the nucleus from last year's squad, plus some excellent recruits. The 1982 roster will be led by five seniors who will all contribute highly to the success of this year's Pioneer team. Dave Daiek, Kevin Kelly, Dave Morgan, Dandy Oskey and Lou Vulovich will all see plenty of action and their leadership may make the difference in this year's team. The junior and sophomore starters returning for this year include Dan Fitzgerald, Morris Lupenec, Steve Mastrogianis, Barrie Vince and Chris Hauer. These players plus some good reserve players

from last year's squad form a solid core of veteran players for the tough fall schedule.

Coach Parsons is also excited about the crop of new talent coming to Oakland University this fall. With the addition of three junior college transfers and four freshmen, there will be plenty of competition for starting positions. Transferring to O.U. will be Scott Kinley (Delta College), Mike Lupenec (Oakland CCC) and Nick O'Shea (Schoolcraft College). The freshmen recruits include Joe Allen (Oak Park, MI), Marty Hagen (Troy, MI), Donn Hilker (King of Prussia, PA) and Paul Larkin (Scarborough, Ontario).

With a strong team returning for 1982, and the toughest schedule in the history of soccer at Oakland University (additions of Lock Haven State College, University of Missouri-St. Louis and the University of Akron), this may well be the year that Pioneer fans see their team push into the national soccer picture.

COACHING STAFF

Gary Parsons — Head Coach

Gary Parsons begins his second year as Head Soccer Coach at Oakland University. His 1981 squad finished their season with a 14-4-1 record (best since 1973) and just missed an NCAA Division II Tournament bid.

A 30-year-old native of Oakham, Massachusetts, Parsons played his college soccer at Plymouth State College and was voted most valuable defensive player in 1972. Plymouth's team made the finals of the New England State College Athletic Conference during his junior and senior years. Since graduating from college, Parsons has held coaching positions at Quabbin Regional High School (Barre, MA), Eastern Illinois University (Charleston), and the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Since coming to Oakland in 1981, Coach Parsons has been very active with the Michigan State Youth Soccer Association and is presently the State Select Coach for Michigan. His State Select teams have participated in matches throughout the midwest; a number of State Select players have been placed at universities throughout the country.

Parsons holds a bachelor's degree in Math and Physical Education (Plymouth State College, 1973-75). He also has a master's

degree in Physical Education (Eastern Illinois University, 1978).

Tad Delorm — Assistant Coach

Tad Delorm begins his first year assisting Coach Parsons with the Pioneer soccer squad. Tad is the starting goalkeeper for the Detroit Express of the A.S.L. and has also played with the Minnesota Kicks and the Atlanta Chiefs of the N.A.S.L. His expertise as a goalkeeper and his experience as a professional player will greatly aid the Pioneers in their drive for the NCAA Tournament.

Tad holds a bachelor's degree in education from Keene State College (Keene, N.H.).

Nancy Limb Hall — Head Athletic Trainer

Nancy is in her fourth year as Head Athletic Trainer at Oakland University. She became certified in 1978 after completing her master's degree in Sports Medicine at Indiana University. Hall holds a B.S. in Phys. Ed. from Michigan State. Prior to completing her graduate work at Indiana, Nancy taught physical education and coached basketball and track for the Homer Community Schools, Homer, Michigan.

DAVE DAIEK, 5'10", 160 lb., Senior
Midfield/Back, Lahser H.S., Bloomfield Hills

Dave played the entire 1981 season as the starting center midfielder where he scored 2 goals and 6 assists. Dave's 10 points put him fifth on the scoring list; more importantly, his steady play will be a key factor in 1982.

DAVE MORGAN, 5'11", 165 lb., Senior
Midfielder/Forward, Univ. H.S., St. Louis, MO

Dave played in 19 games as a junior. He had 1 goal and 1 assist and was used as a back, midfielder and forward. With the loss of Cliff Poe on this year's team, Dave should see plenty of action for the Pioneers.

LOU VULOVICH, 6'3", 185 lb., Senior, Co-Capt.
Back, Harrison H.S., Farmington, MI

Lou missed the first half of the 1981 season with a knee injury, but came back in the second half as the starting sweeper. Lou should lead the defense in 1982.

LINDSAY HAMILTON, 5'8", 145 lb., Junior
Midfielder/Forward, Rochester H.S., MI

Lindsay saw action in 13 games as a sophomore and had 1 goal and 1 assist. He has shown much improvement over the off-season and will challenge for a starting position this year.

KEVIN KELLY, 5'10", 165 lb., Senior
Back, University H.S., St. Louis, MO

Kevin is an excellent defender who has played both inside and outside in the back. Kevin has been a starter 3 years and adds much experience to a defense that should be very solid.

DANDY OSKEY, 5'8", 150 lb., Senior, Co-Capt.
Midfielder, Southwestern H.S., Flint, MI

Dandy had 5 goals and 7 assists as a junior. Dandy is a 3-year starter and was the third highest point leader on the 1981 team. Dandy's speed and stamina make him a valuable starter in the midfield.

DAN FITZGERALD, 6', 160 lb., Junior
Midfielder, North H.S., Granite City, IL

Dan had 2 goals and 10 assists in 19 games as a sophomore. His 10 assists were a team high in 1981 and his improved play should be a key factor for the 1982 squad.

MORRIS LUPENEC, 5'9", 170 lb., Junior

**MEHDI ESKANDARI, 5'9", 140 lb., Sophomore
Forward/Midfielder, Roeper H.S., Birmingham**

Mehdi played in 2 games as a freshman. He has shown good potential and has the ball skills to become a factor this year.

**DAVE MARTILA, 5'11", 170 lb., Sophomore
Goalkeeper, Okemos H.S., Okemos, MI**

Dave was the reserve goalkeeper behind senior bowl representative Mark Hamilton in 1981. Dave has shown good potential and will challenge for the starting position this fall.

**BARRIE VINCE, 5'3", 125 lb., Junior
Forward/Midfielder, Okemos H.S., E. Lansing**

**MIKE LUPENEC, 5'10", 175 lb., Sophomore

Mike is a transfer from Oakland County Community College and a top player in the Michigan Soccer League for Ukrainian Sport Club. He has the ability and necessary experience to help the Pioneers in the back line.

**DONN HILKER, 6'2", 180 lb., Freshman
Midfielder, Upper Merion H.S./King of Prussia**

Donn was an Eastern Pennsylvania All-State player in 1981 from a region of the U.S. that is known for its excellent soccer. He is a versatile player having played back, midfield, and forward for his high school team. He'll add strength to the midfield this year.

Nick is a transfer and former junior college All-American from Schoolcraft College. He is now playing in the Michigan Soccer League for Detroit Sport Club and should give immediate help to Oakland's midfield in 1982.

Joe is considered one of the top youth players in Michigan. He was a member of the 1981 State Select team that played in the Midwest Regionals in Wisconsin. He should help in the back for the 1982 Pioneer squad.

Marty is another top recruit for a forward position. He was chosen by the Michigan Soccer Coaches Association as the top high school player in 1981. He was also chosen as a high school All-American by the National Soccer Coaches Association of America.
