## V. Comments from the Gallery:

- a. J. Hudson, from the Herman Cain campaign, addressed congress and informed them to be involved in the debate this week and that support any candidate is very important. Ms. Malile agreed and thanked Mr. Hudson for coming in.
- b. Alex Van Vliet, from the GSC, addressed congress and explained that the GSC is looking to have a full time office coordinator. She brought some petitions for OUSC to sign if they supported. Mr. Eveslage and Ms. Malile encouraged OUSC to be involved in this and show our support for other student organizations. Mr. McIsaac explained that the GSC was actually created by OUSC in the past, so showing our support would be important.

#### VI. Old Business

- a. C.B. 12-16 Your Voice Heard LIVE Budget Amendment, presented by Ms. Tibbits:
  - i. Ms. Tibbits explained that C.B. 12-16 would add funds to use for Your Voice Heard LIVE for marketing costs, decoration, and t-shirts.
  - ii. C.B. 12-16 passed with 20 "yeas", 0 "neas" and 0 "abstaining".

- a. Campus Development & Environment Committee, *presented by Ms. Malile*: Ms. Malile explained that two spots had opened up on the Campus Development & Environment Committee, for the university senate. The description of the committee was read and some legislators showed interest, but none confirmed for sure on joining the committee.
