Nominations sought for Outstanding AP Award

The nomination deadline for this year's Outstanding AP Award is Monday, March 15. A decision will be made by Wednesday, April 14, and the award winner will be honored at a reception Friday, May 14.

"The Outstanding AP Award is to the AP community as the Research Excellence Award and the Teaching Excellence Award is to the faculty," said Jerry Compton, chemistry lab manager and chair of the AP Award Committee. "We are recognizing that one individual annually who goes well beyond what their job description asks that they do in their AP position. They possess a can-do attitude when dealing with their supervisor, peers and students."

In addition, the Outstanding AP normally is involved in departmental and university activities outside their job description to support the mission of their department and/or Oakland University.

The Outstanding AP Award selection criteria includes:
extraordinary effort in support of institutional mission and strategic plan;
spirit of cooperation;
community and university service.

The recipient receives a \$1,000 stipend from the university.

The selection committee consists of individuals from all areas of the university, with the chair being the Outstanding AP Award honoree from the previous year.

The first Outstanding AP Award was awarded in 1984. Since then, 20 employees representing all levels and departments have won the award.
