OU community raises \$6,900 for Haiti relief efforts

The Oakland University community showed its generous spirit during a recent campus benefit to help support relief efforts in Haiti. Organized by Oakland's own 88.3 FM WXOU radio, "Haiti-palooza" was held Wednesday, Jan. 20, and raised a grand total of \$6,900, including a \$3,400 matching contribution from OU president Gary Russi.

The proceeds from the event will be donated to four charities:

- American Red Cross - \$3272.08
- Salvation Army - \$2,199.82
- Partners in Heath – \$788.85
- Doctors Without Borders – \$561.02

All the funds will be sent directly to the local or national headquarters of each organization.
