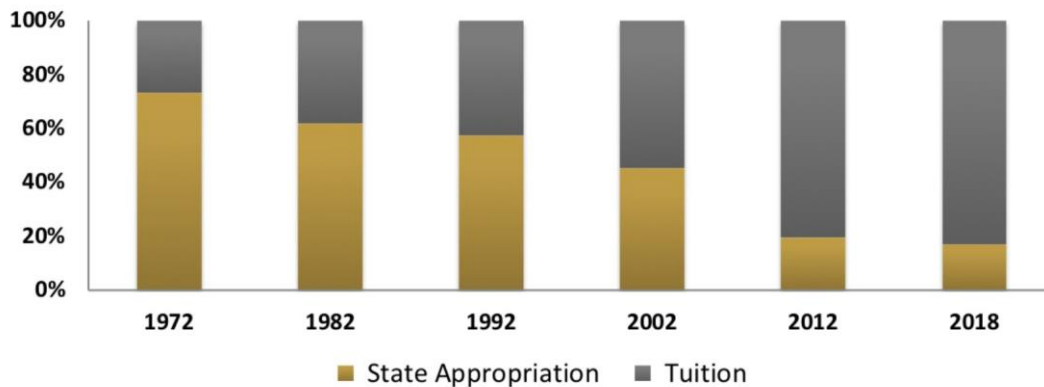


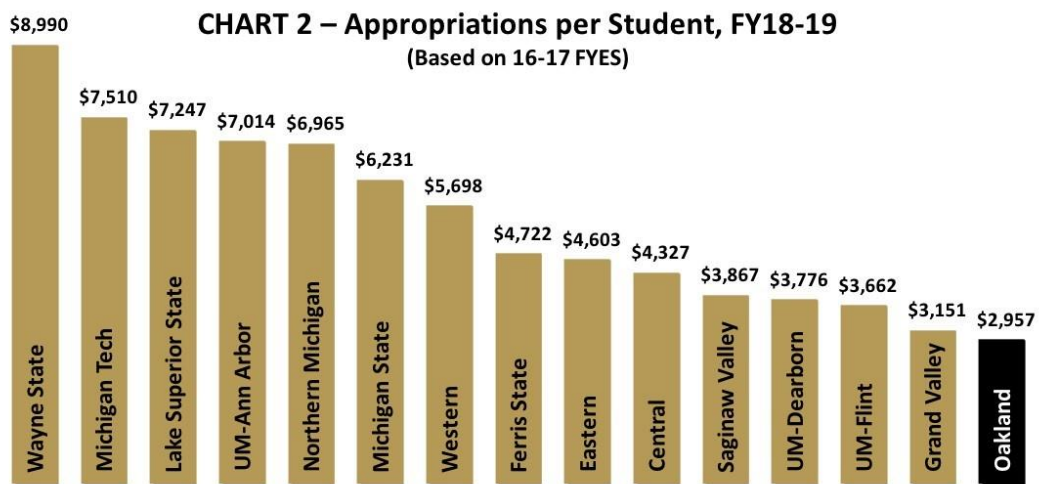

Grizz Facts: A look at state appropriations

The scale of OU's state funding appropriations relative to tuition revenue the University generates has declined dramatically since 1972. In fact, the balance has completely inverted, as depicted in Chart 1. State appropriations now make up just 17 percent of total general fund revenue. OU ranks lowest among Michigan's 15 public universities in appropriations per student, as indicated in Chart 2.
