OU welcomes Mexico's president to campus

President Vicente Fox Quesada of Mexico and First Lady Martha Sahagún de Fox were the honored guests of Oakland University June 18 at a special event in the Athletics Center.

"It is a special honor for me to receive at my university the president of my country and Mrs. Fox," said **Parvati Del Razo**, an Oakland University student from Mexico and the emcee of the event. "Not only because they represent my home but also because they have proven to be a positive force for Mexico."

At the event, it was announced that the **Vicente Fox Quesada Scholarship** has been established to make it possible for students to pursue a degree at Oakland, seek continuing education opportunities, or study in Mexico. Awards from the scholarship may be used for tuition, books, fees, airfare or other costs associated with study-abroad opportunities or fees for continuing education classes. We are truly humbled that our guests are here with us today to share in this great news."

Russi also announced that a tuition differential scholarship has been established so students with Mexican citizenship will be eligible to enroll at Oakland University with the scholarship funds covering the difference between out-of-state tuition and residential tuition rates, starting in fall 2004.
