Meadow Brook Music Festival announces summer schedule

Tickets for **Meadow Brook Music Festival's** expanded summer schedule went on sale this week.

The annual festival, held on Oakland University's campus throughout the summer, offers a variety in entertainment choices including pop, rock, country, jazz and folk music, comedy, family shows and stage productions. It also is the summer home for the Detroit Symphony Orchestra.

Two new weekend events - Fine Art at Meadow Brook and the Michigan Wine and Food Festival - are on this year's schedule.

This year's festival runs June 16-August 31, with the first event, Fine Art at Meadow Brook, set for June 16-17. The outdoor venue offers both lawn and pavilion seating.
