Ward to represent OU at NCAA meet

Senior Danielle Ward (Brighton, Mich.) has been selected to represent Oakland University at the 2003 Women's NCAA Swimming and Diving Championships in Auburn, Ala., the weekend of March 20-22.

Ward made the NCAA consideration time in the 100 freestyle event with a time of 50.06. NCAA automatic qualifying standard was 49.63. She currently is ranked 28th in the country in that event. A total of 99 competitors will be swimming in the 100 freestyle at the NCAA championship at Auburn University.

Since Ward was invited to compete in the 100 freestyle, she also will participate in the 200 free. Ward's seeded time in that event is 1:50.20, which places her 78th in the competition. The 200 freestyle event will see 99 swimmers battle for the NCAA championship title.

Both of Ward's seeding times were swam at the 2003 National Independent Conference Championships hosted by Oakland University Feb. 26-March 1. The Golden Grizzlies **women's team won the championship** for their second year in a row while the men's team placed fourth.
