

From RLA Chair Linda Pavonetti and Associate Professor Jim Cipielewski: This July, the Reading and Language Arts department will again offer the Authors' and Illustrators' Art and Craft course — RDG 570 — as an elective for students across campus and beyond. Each day for four weeks, illustrators and authors of children's books describe how they employ their craft to share stories with readers. In its current format, this class has been offered for 17 years, but it has its roots in the 1970s when Bill Martin Jr. (author of Brown Bear, Brown Bear and many others) taught standing-room only classes in the Oakland Center Gold Rooms. We have had outstanding authors and illustrators including winners of the most prestigious awards in children's literature, namely the Newbery, The Caldecott and the Coretta Scott King Award. This year is no different.

The ERL receives new books directly from publishers, which are usually shelved accordingly in the **Trade Book Examination Center (http://www.oakland.edu/erl/tradebook)** for the entire year. The ERL currently has close to 2,000 books that were published in 2013, from a wide variety of publishers. The ERL has heard that those buying books would appreciate an opportunity to read and compare books before purchasing, but often local bookstores do not carry the titles you need. There will also be a Horn Book Guide and other review sources available in the ERL to help with the selection process.

All of the children's and young adult trade books, published in 2013, will be on display. They will be arranged in stations around the ERL according to Dewey Decimal categories; fiction will be divided between chapter books/picture books, alphabetically by author. Each attendee will be given a checklist of all titles to help keep track of preferred books.
