Applications accepted for post-baccalaureate program

Oakland University's **School of Education and Human Services** is accepting applications for its post-baccalaureate elementary teacher certification program. Cohort groups will be held at the Macomb Intermediate School District Building in Clinton Township and area schools in Oakland County. Applicants who have extensive coursework in math, science and Spanish and indicate a preference to teach those subjects will be given additional consideration because of the need for elementary and middle school teachers in those areas. The program is designed for working professionals and career changers. Program courses may be completed in 21 to 24 months, depending on the timing of student teaching.
