SPECIAL ART EXHIBIT: The Department of Special Education and Vocational Rehabilitation of Wayne State University, in cooperation with the Michigan Society for Crippled Children and Adults Inc., will present an exhibit of international art April 3-14. The exhibit will be held in conjunction with the International Convention of the Council for Exceptional Children to be held in Detroit, April 4-8. This art collection has been accumulated from 11 foreign countries and 17 American institutions. The exhibit features work by mentally retarded, psychotic, aphasic, cerebral palsied and deaf mute persons who have special talents in art. The exhibit was assembled by Dr. Ionel Rapaport of the University of Wisconsin Psychiatric Institute and has been shown in the United States and at the Institut Pedagogique Nationale in Paris. It has created high interest in art as a media of expression for the non-verbal person. The exhibit will be housed in the Community Arts Auditorium at Wayne State University, Cass and Kirby, Detroit. It will be open to the public from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m., weekdays. There will be no charge for admission.
