Manohar Das, professor of engineering, has been a member of the School of Engineering and Computer Science faculty since 1984. He has served as the chair of the Undergraduate Affairs Committee of the Department of Electrical and Systems Engineering since 2001. The past two years were critical years for this committee due to significant preparations needed for the accreditation and assessment process of the department.

In collaboration with other committee members, Das developed many of the assessment tools needed for the accreditation process. In addition, he analyzed all the assessment data and prepared the self-study reports for both Electrical Engineering and Systems Engineering programs.

During the past two decades, Das has supervised 12 Ph.D. dissertations in the areas of controls, signal processing and image processing. He is currently supervising four more doctoral students. He has received a number of grants from Ford Motor Company, the Air Force Office of Scientific Research and other organizations to support his research activities. He has also served as an associate editor of the journal "Simulation" and as a reviewer for several archival journals.
