"Teachers Learning Together at Auburn Elementary: Supporting Classroom Teachers as Associated Teacher Educators" (2017) written by Cynthia Carver, Marcia Hudson, Molly Abbott, Sarah Bruha, Colleen Bugaj, Jenny Johnson and Serena Stock was recently published in *Dynamic Principles of Professional Development: Essential Elements of Effective Teacher Preparation*, and edited by Caroline Crawford and Sandra Hardy.

New Bilingual Arabic/English Books in the ERL

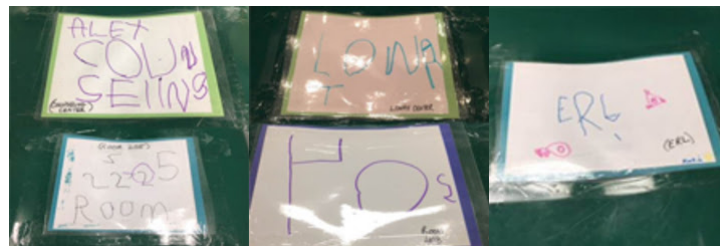
Recently, the ERL purchased a selection of bilingual, [Arabic/English children's books](#), and have put them on display on the trifold near the circulation desk.
