



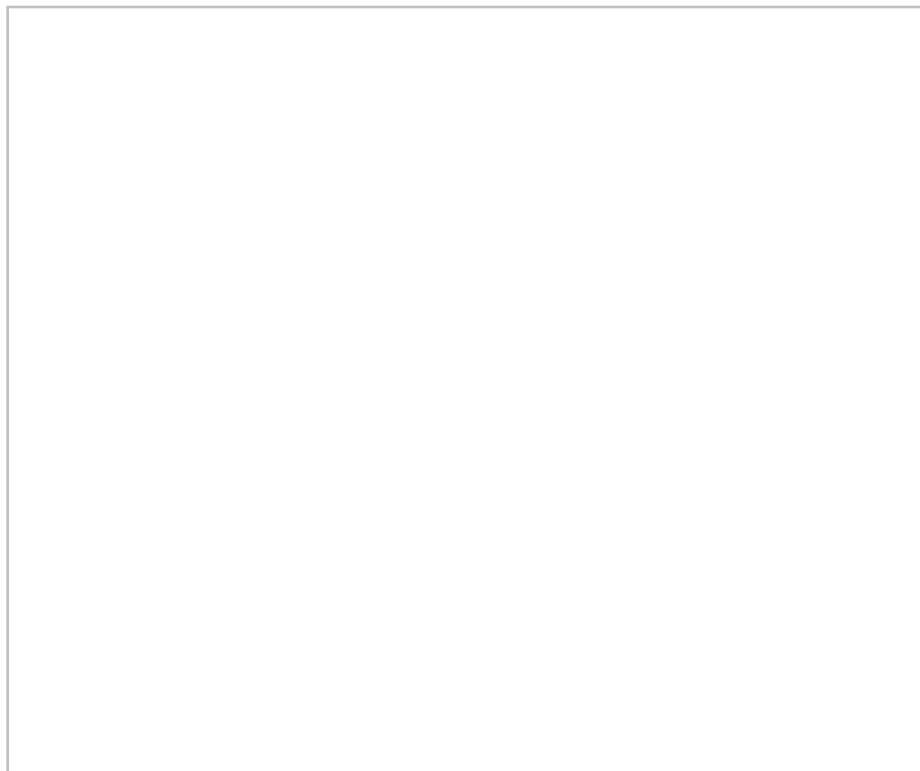

PubMed Search Tip of the Month: Refining Your Search with Filters

PubMed searchers often lament that they find too many results or that their results are not relevant. A good way to limit your retrieval and improve precision is to use the **Filters feature** located on the left side of the search screen.

Our favorites are Article Types, Publication Dates, Languages, and Ages, the latter of which is the most efficient way to limit your PubMed search to specific age groups.

To Use Filters:

1. Run a search in [PubMed](#)
2. Click the link "Show additional filters" to see all available filters
3. Check the additional filters you'd like to use. For example, I'd like to limit my search to systematic reviews written in English about obesity in grade-school age children so I choose the Languages and Ages boxes. This will cause those options to display so I can select them. Note that check marks will appear next to the active filters.



Additional Notes about Filters:

- When filters are selected a Filters activated message will display on the results page.
- To turn off filters, click either the "Clear all" link to remove all the filters, the "clear" link next to a filter category to clear the selections within that category, or the individual filter.
- Citations may be excluded for some filter selections because they have not yet completed the MEDLINE indexing process.
