Water main break repairs under way

The university experienced a water main break on the morning of Monday, Dec. 9 just north of North foundation Hall. To enable a contractor to repair the line, water service has had to be shut off for North Foundation Hall, South Foundation Hall and the Oakland Center.

Occupants of those buildings will have to use restroom facilities in Wilson Hall, O'Dowd Hall or the Kresge Library.

Food service at the Pioneer Food in the Oakland Center has been temporarily suspended while repairs are being made. However, prepackaged salads and sandwiches are available at the Starbucks counter.

It is anticipated that repairs can be made and all services restored by this afternoon.
