Participants in and observers of the Friday commencement ceremony are welcome to use available parking spaces in other lots across campus.

Participants and observers attending the 9 a.m. commencement exercise on Saturday will be directed to use parking lots on the south side of Main Campus. These include all lots south of the University's Main entrance off Squirrel Road and south of the Recreation and Athletics Center, located on the east side of Main Campus.

Participants and observers attending the 1 p.m. commencement exercise will be directed to use parking lots on the north side of Main Campus. These include all lots north of the University's main entrance and north of the Recreation and Athletics Center, excluding the P-16 lot.

Participants and observers attending the 5 p.m. commencement exercise will be directed to use parking lots on the south side of Main Campus, as described above.
