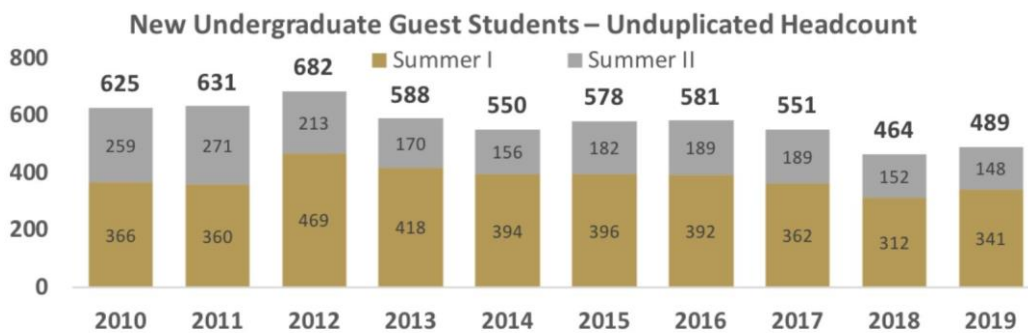

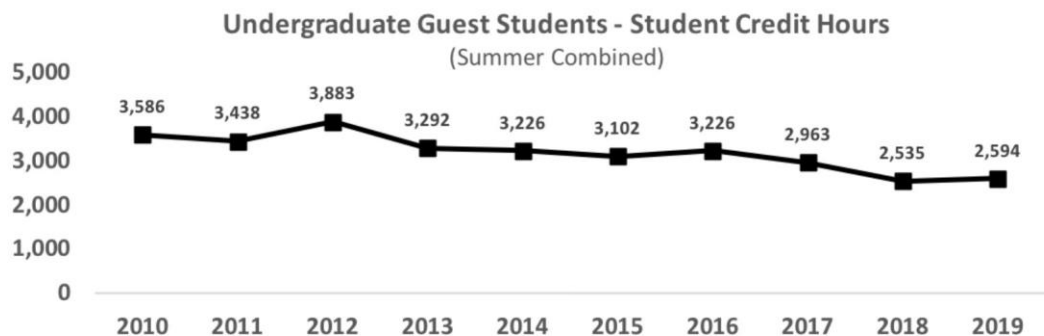

Grizz Facts: A look at guest student enrollment

Guest students are those enrolled at another college or university who take courses at OU to transfer to their home school. Guest student headcount and student credit hours have been decreasing in recent years, but headcount was up 5.4 percent and credit hours were up 2.3 percent for summer 2019. The most common courses taken by guest students during summer terms include courses in natural sciences and mathematics.
