Pieter Frick named new SECS dean

Oakland University has named its new dean of the **School of Engineering and Computer Science**.

Dr. Pieter A. Frick, dean of San Diego State University's College of Engineering, will join OU on October 15, pending approval of the Faculty Reappointment and Promotion Committee (FRPC) and the Board of Trustees.

"Dr. Frick comes to us with a history of interest in our university and a wealth of accomplishments to his credit," said Virinder K. Moudgil, interim vice president of Academic Affairs and provost. "Prior to his current position, he served as dean of the College of Engineering and Applied Science at the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs. His research is widely published in professional journals. His arrival at OU will enhance the academic programs of the school, and strengthen the ties to industry and collaborations with the surrounding community."

Frick has served as the dean of the College of Engineering at San Diego State University since 1995 and was the dean of the College of Engineering and Applied Science at the University of Colorado from 1987 to 1995. Prior to that, he worked as a professor and department head of the Department of Electrical Engineering at Portland State University from 1980-1987; department head of the Department of Computer Science at Portland State University from 1984 to 1987; associate professor of electrical and computer engineering at Oregon State University from 1978 to 1980; and assistant professor of electrical and computer engineering at Oregon State University from 1973-1978.

Frick has a Ph.D. and D.I.C. in Control Systems from London University.
