Main university parking lot to close for repairs

Oakland University will begin repairs and repaving of the main university parking lot (P-1) on Monday, August 6. From August 6-31, portions or all of the 55,000-square-yard lot will be closed. The lot is located west of North and South Foundation Halls, Wilson Hall, Meadow Brook Theatre and the Graham Health Center.

While work is in progress, drivers should use other parking lots in the vicinity. During the entire construction period, only the Meadow Brook Road entrances to P-1 will be available. The Squirrel Road entrance to P-1 will be closed.

Work on the lot will proceed according to the following schedule:

- August 6-13 – The middle portion of the lot, facing North Foundation Hall and Wilson Hall, will be open. The remainder of P-1 will be closed.
- August 14-31 – The entire lot will be closed.
- September 1 – The entire lot will reopen.

“We recognize the closure will be a temporary inconvenience, but it’s required to ensure that repaving of the entire lot is completed before the fall term,” said Rusty Postlewate, associate vice president for facilities management. “Everyone’s patience is appreciated.”
