Oakland University's chapter of the **Golden Key International Honour Society** is raking in the awards. The chapter received a Key Chapter Award at the 2001 International Convention in Dallas in early August.

The OU chapter was one of 32 from around the world to receive this prestigious award. There are 317 chapters worldwide. The award recognizes the chapter for outstanding work in scholarship, leadership and community service.
