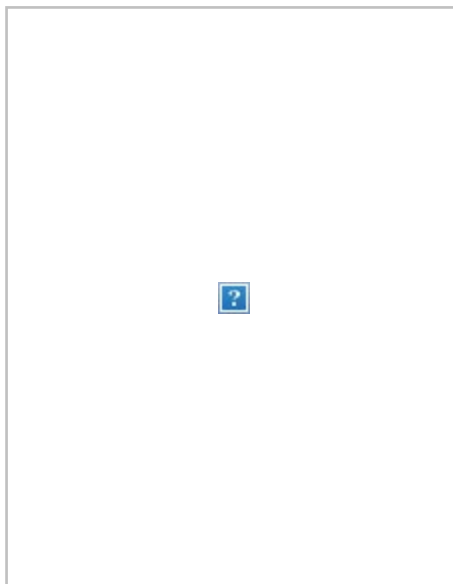
New Library Initiative: OUWB Publication List

With over 1500 affiliates, our school has an immense repertoire of scholarly activity to showcase. This quarterly report recognizes and provides quick access links to our authors' journal articles, meeting abstracts, book chapters, books, and other published works.

Easier Off-Campus Access to Library Online Resources OU Libraries has streamlined off-campus access to our online resources. OU students, faculty and staff can log into library resources using their

standard OU NetIDs. We hope the new process will greatly simplify remote access to our online databases, journals, and articles, as it eliminates the need for users to memorize a different login/password. For those faculty based at Beaumont, you will need to activate your NetID and set-up a password in order to access our resources from off-campus. Resource Updates

New Trial: AccessPhysiotherapy The Medical Library now has trial access to AccessPhysiotherapy through July 14, 2013. AccessPhysiotherapy is geared primarily to physical therapy students, but includes access to "Anatomy & Physiology Revealed," an interactive cadaver and dissection tool featuring the anatomy of all human organs systems with animation, images, and quizzes and was co-authored by the OUWB School of Medicine's Mark Hankin.

New eResources The Medical Library has subscribed to two new eResources this month. Simply click on the resource title for access; if you are off-campus, you will need to login with your NetID and password.

- **Health & Psychosocial Instruments (HaPI)** - New database providing access to article citations containing information on measurement instruments (questionnaires, interview schedules, checklists, index measures, coding schemes/ manuals, rating scales, projective techniques, vignettes/scenarios, tests) in the health fields, psychosocial sciences, organizational behavior, and library and information science.
- **LWW Health Library** - The Medical Library now has access to an extensive eBook collection from Lippincott, Williams, & Wilkins featuring 26 basic science books, including many of the OUWB required and recommended course textbooks.
