Pride Month Youth Books

Oakland University's Pride Month begins on March 12 this year. Starting March 19, the ERL will be displaying youth books that feature LGBTQ characters. If you're looking for books in the library catalog on these topics, try using "advanced search," then limit to the ERL using the drop-down menu and enter terms such as homosexuality, lesbians, transgender youth, transsexuals, and sex roles. The Library of Congress dictates the subject headings for libraries, so if you are having trouble locating specific books, contact the ERL.



Looking for young adult books? Try our reference book: *The heart has its reasons: young adult literature with gay/lesbian/queer content*; which provides a decade-by-decade discussion of the most important novels with homosexual, bisexual, or transgender themes.

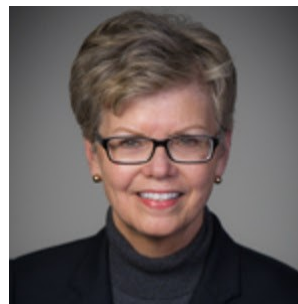
