Oakland University's School of Business Administration is offering classes in Personal Financial Planning, beginning the week of January 15. Classes will be held Monday through Friday in the evenings at Derby School in Birmingham, and Saturday mornings at Macomb's University Center in Clinton Township.

The program is a Certified Financial Planner Board-registered program and upon completion, students earn a Certificate in Personal Financial Planning and are eligible to sit for the Certified Financial Planner exam.
