OU to continue nursing scholarship

Oakland University's **School of Nursing** will continue to award the Helene Fuld Health Trust scholarship until July 31 for registered nurses (RNs) to finish their nursing education by earning a Bachelor's of Science in Nursing at OU.

Scholarship recipients are chosen on both a need and merit basis. They receive between \$950 and \$1,325 per term if they carry eight credits, maintain a 2.5 grade point average and participate in grant evaluation activities.

The scholarship fund, established in 2000, originally was for economically disadvantaged nurses who live or work in Pontiac. This year, RNs who work or live outside of Pontiac also are eligible.

The scholarship is made possible through the mutual cooperation of Pontiac leaders, community churches and Oakland University's **School of Nursing** under the leadership of Professor Justine Speer.
