OU hosting information nights for executive MBA program

Oakland University's **School of Business Administration** (SBA) will host two informal open houses spotlighting its Executive MBA in Healthcare Management program on Thursday, March 29, and Tuesday, April 24, from 6:30-8 p.m. in the R. Hugh and Nancy Elliott Hall of Business and Information Technology on the university's campus.

The EMBA-HCM is designed to provide health care professionals with an understanding of the concepts and skills that will assist them in effective management in the health care industry. To meet the needs of busy health care professionals who cannot easily attend traditional class meeting times, classes in the EMBA-HCM meet on Friday afternoons and all day Saturday on alternative weekends. The entire program takes 21 months to complete and consists of two 10-weekend terms and one three-weekend term during the first year, and two 10-weekend terms in the second year.
