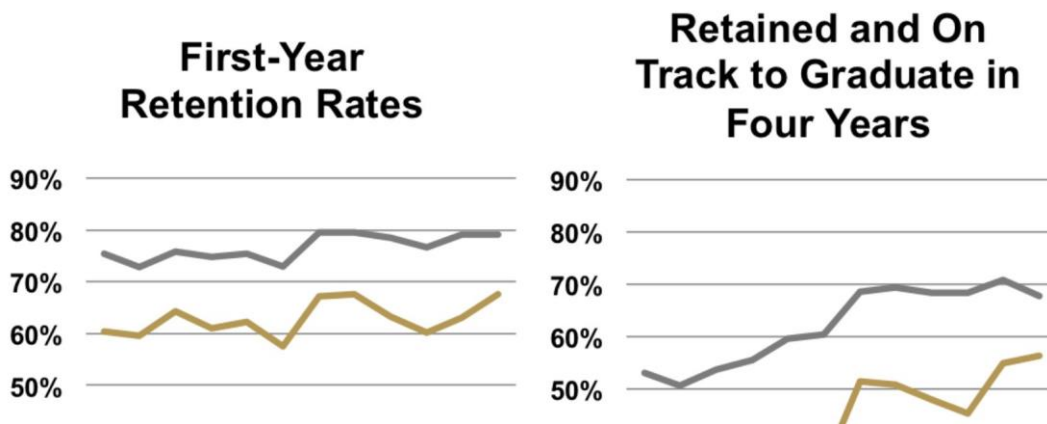

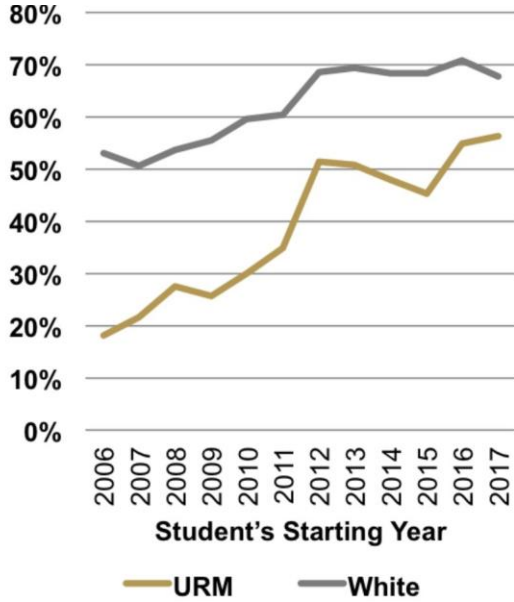
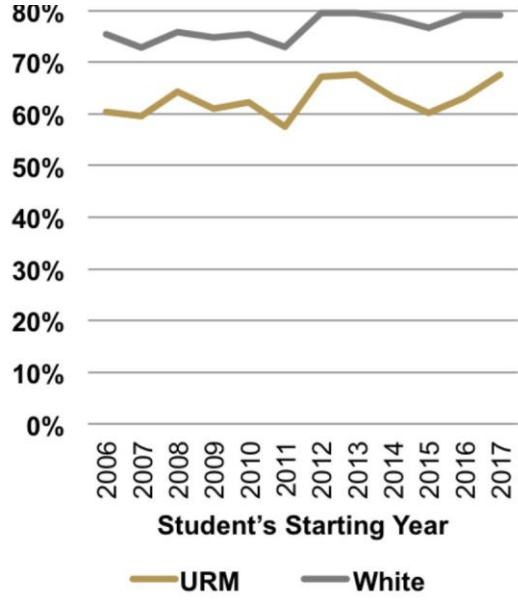
Grizz Facts: A look at URM retention and "on track" rates

The chart at lower left shows that first-year retention rates for first-time, full-time underrepresented minority (URM) students have improved slightly over the past decade.

As indicated in the chart at lower right, the percentage of URM students ontrack to graduate – those who started their second year with 28 or more completed credits – reached a record high this past year.

Meanwhile, the gap between the percentage of URM students and white students retained and on track to graduate, which has been as broad as 30 percent, has now closed to 11 percent.
