Golf tournament supports women's athletics

Oakland University's eighth annual Ford Cup Golf Tournament is scheduled for Monday, June 24, at **Katke-Cousins and R&S Sharf golf courses**.

All proceeds from the tournament benefit **women's athletics** and help underwrite scholarships, mentoring and advising programs, life-skills programs, equipment purchases, travel and recruiting expenses, and maintaining first-class facilities for more than 130 female student athletes.

This year, participants have the choice of which course — Katke-Cousins or R&S Sharf — they will play.

The entry fee for **Katke-Cousins Golf Course** is \$175. The fee for **R&S Sharf Golf Course** is \$300. Entry fees include greens fees and cart, tee prize, pre-tee time breakfast, door prizes, hole-in-one prizes, silent auction and lunch at **Meadow Brook Hall**.

Registration and a continental breakfast is at 7 a.m. and the shotgun start (four-person scramble) begins at 8 a.m.

OU alum and Vice President for Environmental and Safety Engineering at Ford Motor Company, Susan Cischke, is the honorary chairperson. This is her first year chairing the event, which is sponsored by 31 Metro Detroit Ford Dealers, Pepsi and the Office of the President.
