Construction update: Squirrel Road repairs and University Drive at I-75

Squirrel Road will be reduced by one lane in each direction for repairs beginning the week of October 12 from Featherstone to University.

Meanwhile, Squirrel north of Walton continues re-pavement work.

Squirrel Road (Featherstone Road to University Drive)

According to the City of Auburn Hills, Squirrel Road will be reduced to one lane of travel in each direction from Featherstone Road to University Drive beginning the week of October 12. Construction contractors will be repairing various concrete panels of roadway to maintain the concrete overlay that was constructed in 2010. One lane in each direction will be closed simultaneously for repairs.

Squirrel Road (north of Walton Blvd to Tienken Road)

Squirrel Road from Walton Blvd. north to Tienken Road road work should be completed in late October/first week of November with the roadway re-opened to two-way traffic shortly thereafter.

Westbound University Drive to northbound I-75 closed from October 5-20

University Drive at I-75

The Michigan Department of Transportation also sent this notification: Beginning today through October 20, the westbound University Drive ramp to northbound I-75 will close for reconstruction. The detour is northbound Squirrel Road to westbound Walton Blvd. to northbound Opdyke Road to northbound Lapeer Road to I-75.
