Since joining the faculty in 1970, Ann Pogany has made numerous contributions to the library and the university.

Pogany serves as the coordinator of technical services, offering expertise regarding the cataloging and organization of the library's print collections as well as the increasing number of electronic holdings. She was the architect of the customized cataloging system developed for the Jane M. Bingham Collection of Historical Children's Literature. In addition, she participates in the library's active information literacy program with the Department of Rhetoric, Communication and Journalism. Pogany also is the library's liaison to the departments of Art and Art History, Philosophy, and Music, Theatre and Dance, working closely with faculty coordinators to select and acquire strong collections that support their teaching, scholarship and creative endeavors.

As a part of this effort, she developed and submitted grant proposals to enrich the library's collections, most recently applying for the 2002-03 James C. Dance Award in the performing arts. Pogany has been an active contributor to numerous committees and task forces over the years, most notably serving as chair of the Faculty Re-employment and Promotion Committee.
