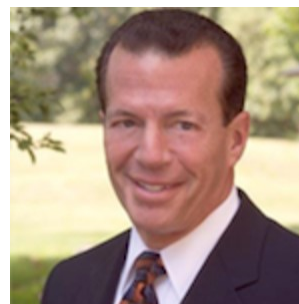

Remembering Barry Klein

Last week, Oakland University alumnus Barry Klein (CAS '68) passed away at the age of 73 after a long battle with Alzheimer's disease. Barry was a great friend and supporter of the Oakland University community from his time as a student up until his passing.

In 1997, Barry and his mother, Helen Klein, established an endowed scholarship in memory of his father, George, to benefit graduate students interested in addictions counseling, education or treatment and enrolled in the counseling programs in the School of Education and Human Services. The George R. and Helen Klein Memorial Endowed Scholarship has served countless students over the years and will remain an important student resource for years to come.



“Barry leaves an incredible legacy in support of the College of Arts and Sciences, Honors College, and the School of Education and Human Services,” said Vice President of University Advancement Mike Westfall in a statement. “His memory will live on through the amazing things our faculty and students are able to accomplish as a result of his remarkable support.”
