## Copy Stop closing due to budget cuts, lower demand

Copy Stop etc. is closing its doors for good on Wednesday, June 30, because of budget reductions and a decreasing demand for services.

"This past fiscal year was especially difficult for the Copy Stop because of the overall budget reduction. Plus, departments throughout OU are relying on the Copy Stop less because they are purchasing their own high-tech copiers," said Laurel McDaniel, director of University Services/Property Management.

Services previously offered by the Copy Stop will be available through **University Services**, located in the Police and Support Services Building. Services include black and white and color prints, faxing, laminating, design, binding, drilling, cutting and folding.

Mail Services, also located in the Police and Support Services Building, offers stamps, packaging, UPS, FedEx, USPS, inserting, tabbing and labeling.

A coin-operated copier and a drop box with daily collection times of 11 a.m. and 2 p.m. will be available at the Oakland Center. In addition, free pick-up and delivery is offered by calling Mail Services at (248) 370-2281.

"I'm confident OU employees will find the same excellent and convenient service they received at the Copy Stop through University Services," McDaniel said.

OU will incur expenditure reductions when the Copy Stop's full-time employee retires in July. In addition, \$10,000 will be saved annually for the lease and maintenance of copiers, fax machines and mail meters.
