OU's International Night celebrates different cultures

Oakland University's International Student Organization (ISO) is hosting International Night Friday, April 6, from 7-11 p.m. in the **Oakland Center** on the university's campus.

"International Night is one of the most exciting, fun and educational events at OU," said Lisa Heaps-Seguchi, assistant director of the International Students and Scholars at Oakland University.

The event will feature ethnic food and music from a variety of countries, dance performances by groups representing cultures from around the world and displays presenting OU's diverse community of students, faculty, and staff.

There are 602 international students from 48 different countries at Oakland University. The ISO brings the International Night to OU's campus for the third time since last April.
