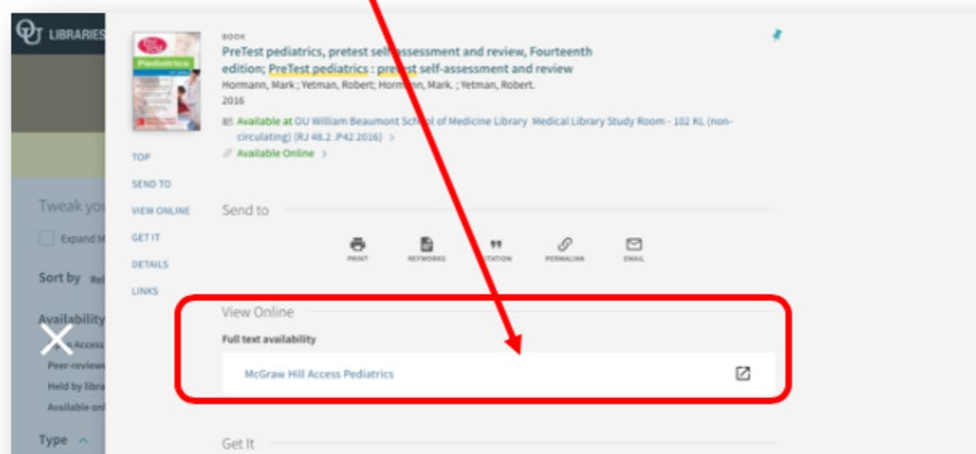
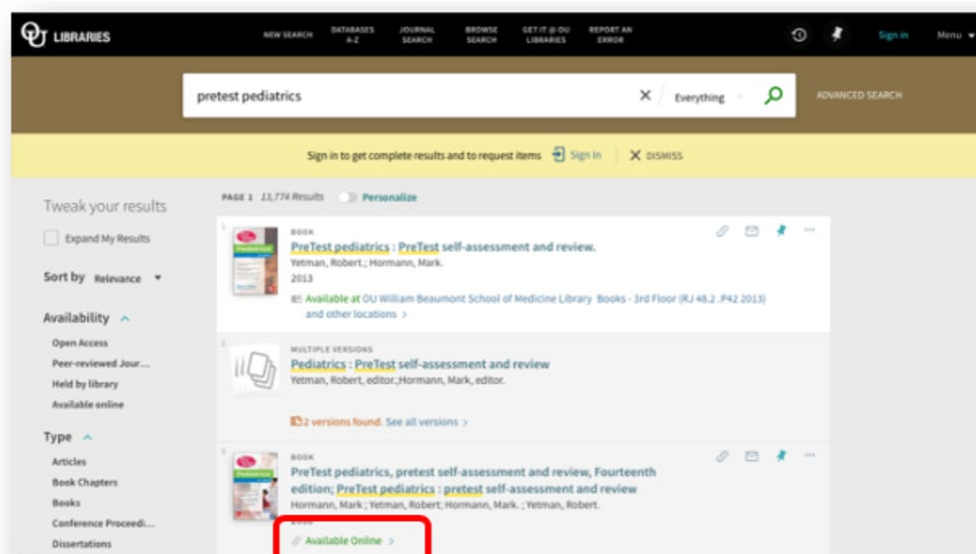

Resource News: OU Libraries' New Library OneSearch

OU Libraries' [Library OneSearch](#) has a new look this year! As part of a larger upgrade to a new library system called Alma in July, Library OneSearch now uses Alma's Primo integrated resource discovery system. The system comes with a variety of new features including the ability to:

- Filter your searches by resource type, availability, subject, author, and more
- Log in to your library account using your campus NetID and password
- Create custom searches including the ability to specify up to five preferred disciplines (e.g. Medicine, Nursing, Psychology) to prioritize results within those disciplines
- Save entire searches or individual results to your favorites for review later or just browse your search history
- View the books you have checked out, their due dates, and renew them online

To access electronic materials (books, journals, etc), simply search for the item in the search box, click the item's title or 'Available Online,' and you will be directed to the resource.



The new system has some nice features, and although there have been some implementation

hiccups, OU Libraries staff are working diligently to identify problems and fix them.
