DSO Summer Institute performs at OU

Students enrolled in the **Detroit Symphony Orchestra Summer Institute at Meadow Brook** are staging performances to showcase their talents at Oakland University's Varner Recital Hall. The performances run from Friday, July 27, to Sunday, July 29, and are free and open to the public.

The Chamber Ensembles perform on Friday, July 27, at 11 a.m. The Brass and Percussion Ensemble performs on Saturday, July 28 at 11 a.m. and the Civic Jazz Orchestra performs at 2 p.m. The DSO Summer Institute Orchestra performs on Sunday, July 29, at noon.

The DSO Summer Institute at Meadow Brook is a two-week intensive, orchestral training camp held at Oakland University for students from grade school to college. DSO musicians introduce the students to standard works of chamber music and orchestra literature, culminating with the performances. The program also includes special lecture/demonstrations, master classes and sectional rehearsals with DSO musicians, and academic classes in music theory and orchestral literature taught by local musical personalities.
