CONNELLAN JOINS PRESIDENT'S OFFICE AS ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT

William W. Connellan joins the staff today (Monday) in a newly-created position of assistant to the president. An OU alumnus, he has been a staff writer in the field of higher education for the *Detroit News* since 1968. He graduated cum laude in 1967, with departmental honors in both history and political science, and has completed much of the requirements for an M.A. in political science at the University of Michigan.

While an undergraduate Connellan served for several years on the staff of the *Observer* and was editor of the paper when he graduated. He and his wife, the former Mary Solonika, who graduated from OU in 1969, are both active in the OU Alumni Council. Mrs. Connellan is a teacher at Sacred Heart Elementary School in Grosse Ile. They live in Southgate.

MUSIC ANTIQUA

Collegium Musicum, directed by Lyle Nordstrom, will give its first concert of the year at 8 p.m. Thursday in 110 Performing Arts. Music of Josquin des Prés, court composer to Duke Hercules of Ferrara in the early 16th century, will be featured. Vocal soloists and choral work by the Collegium Singers will accompany the instrumentalists using replicas of the instruments of the time -- including recorders, crumhorns, lutes, shawms and viols. The concert, sponsored by the music department, is free.

FORSTER EXPERT TO SPEAK

The English Department and Area Studies will co-sponsor a lecture by Prof. V. A. Shahane of Osmania University, Hyderabad, India, at 2 p.m. Wednesday in the Gold Room. His topic will be "E. M. Forster and the Indian Experience." Shahane, currently visiting professor of English at Wayne State University, is the author of *E. M. Forster -- A Reassessment* and editor of *Perspectives on E. M. Forster's A Passage to India*.
