Workshop offered for educators and counselors

Oakland University's **School of Education and Human Services** is sponsoring "The Transition Process: Planning Services and Options for Special-Needs Students," a workshop for educators, agency and school counselors, and administrators. The course will be held June 23-26 from 8:30 a.m.-3:45 p.m. at Oakland Community College's Auburn Hills campus.

Lynn A. Boza, Ph.D., a vocational rehabilitation consultant to Michigan's Transition Services Project, will lead the course. Boza's project team offers technical assistance and training to educators, agencies and families about transition services for youth with disabilities. She has presented at state and national conferences and is president-elect of the National Association for Rehabilitation Leadership.

Cost of the workshop is \$295. State board continuing education units (SB-CEUs) are available. Participants have the option to take the course for two university graduate credits for an additional fee.
