

OAKLAND UNIVERSITY

ADMINISTRATIVE GROUP MEETING

July 7, 1964

PRESENT: Messrs. Beardslee, Eklund, Hicks, Matthews, Stoutenburg, Swanson, Varner and Wilder.

ABSENT: Messrs. McKay, O'Dowd and Sells.

The meeting for new faculty and staff called for September 1, and 2, by Dean O'Dowd will be held in Mrs. Wilson's Club House.

Chancellor Varner will recommend to the Board of Trustees at their next meeting that the new classroom-office building be named The Mitilda R. Wilson Building.

Mr. Stoutenburg reported that applications for fall, 1964, continue 70% ahead of last year and tuition deposits remain about 40% ahead. Also, Mr. Stoutenburg announced that Mr. Shadrick will resign July 31, to become the Director of Admissions at The University of Detroit.

Mr. Eklund distributed his letter to the Alumni announcing the First Reunion on August 1, and described some of the events planned for this occasion.

Mr. Beardslee reported that the CQT total scores for the first 245 new students tested at the Summer Orientation Sessions are ranging from 5 to 10 points above last year's class. Mr. Matthews suggested that this information be reported by Mr. Obear on a regular basis to the freshmen advisors. Mr. Stoutenburg agreed to talk with Mr. Obear on this subject.

Mr. Hicks indicated that the Meadow Brook Festival and all its parts are taking shape and he is pleased with the situation at this time. He also stated approximately 5,000 tickets have been sold.

Mr. Beardslee indicated that the faculty felt the manner in which the Chancellor announced the lifting of the intercollegiate athletic prohibition was insulting to them.
