Virinder Moudgil, interim vice president of Academic Affairs and provost, also will recognize the **2002 Distinguished Professors** — **Sheldon Appleton**, professor of political science; **Ronald Cramer**, professor of education; and **Jane Donahue Eberwein**, professor of English. Appleton, Cramer and Eberwein join just seven other Oakland faculty members who have been honored with this prestigious status.

The faculty rank of distinguished professor was created by the Board of Trustees in 1988. The criteria is based on preeminence in scholarship, teaching and public or professional service.

A luncheon will follow the presentation. Participation is by invitation only.

The Faculty Recognition Luncheon, which honors OU faculty members for their dedication and excellence in teaching and research, is part of the Founders' Day activities. Founders' Day honors the memory of benefactors Alfred and Matilda Dodge Wilson, who donated 1,500 acres and \$2 million to establish the university.
