Organ & Bone Marrow Donor Registration Drive: October 6 - 8

The Medical Library is proud to host our third annual organ, eye, and tissue donor registration drive as part of Michigan Libraries for Life, a partnership between **Gift of Life Michigan** and over 40 local health sciences, medical, public, academic, and hospital libraries across Michigan.



This year, we've partnered with the OUWB Student National Medical Association (SNMA), the Minority Association of Pre-Medical Students (MAPS), and OUWB Diversity and Inclusion to also host a dual drive to register bone marrow donors for **Be the Match**.

The drive will be held October 6 - 8 in the main hallway of the Oakland Center immediately following our kick-off event at 12:00 noon in the Fireside Lounge. Hear from Dean Robert Folberg, a cornea transplant recipient, and Craig Bowman (*husband of our own Patti Bowman!*), whose bone marrow transplant cured his blood cancer.
