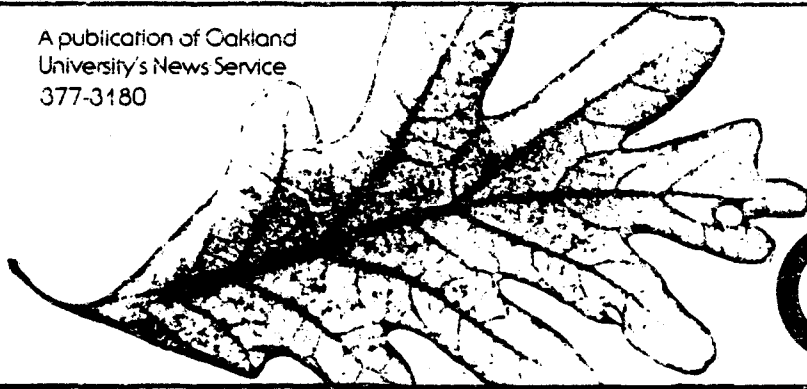

The UAW Clerical Technical Association struck the university this morning after negotiations that lasted the weekend and into the early morning hours ended without agreement. The two parties bargained with the aid of a mediator and there was some movement, however substantial economic differences remain. Negotiations resume at 6 p.m. today.

Registration is being held as scheduled both for university credit courses and for noncredit courses offered by the Division of Continuing Education. Meadow Brook Hall is open. University classes begin at 4:30 p.m., Wednesday, Aug. 29, with the first full day of classes on Thursday, Aug. 30.

Negotiations between the university and the OU Chapter of the American Association of University Professors are continuing. The AAUP contract expired July 1.
