Fatma Mili

Fatma Mili, associate professor of computer science and engineering, has gained recognition for research in the area of engineering design knowledge through sustained funding, the publication of her work, student supervision and active participation in the academic community.

Theoretical results have been published in the premier journal in her field and in book chapters, and presented at major conferences. In addition, Mili has received peer recognition, earning appointments as a reviewer and program committee member of the major events related to engineering design knowledge. Her research has been continuously funded by DaimlerChrysler.

She has been very active in recruiting and mentoring students. In 2000-2001, she recruited three Ph.D. candidates and two master's-level students. She also mentored prospective women students applying for National Science Foundation grants and initiating research programs.
