a. Main Motion

MOVED that each School or Department shall develop a program to increase understanding of racial and cultural diversity issues and to examine especially those racial and cultural diversity issues important to that particular discipline. Reports of accomplishments and programming, including ways in which you plan to implement programming in 1991-92, should be submitted by September 30, 1991, to the Senate Committee on Human Relations.

MOVED that the motion be amended to move the reporting date from September 30 to October 15, 1991.

scholarships to enhance the diversity of the university's student population.
