

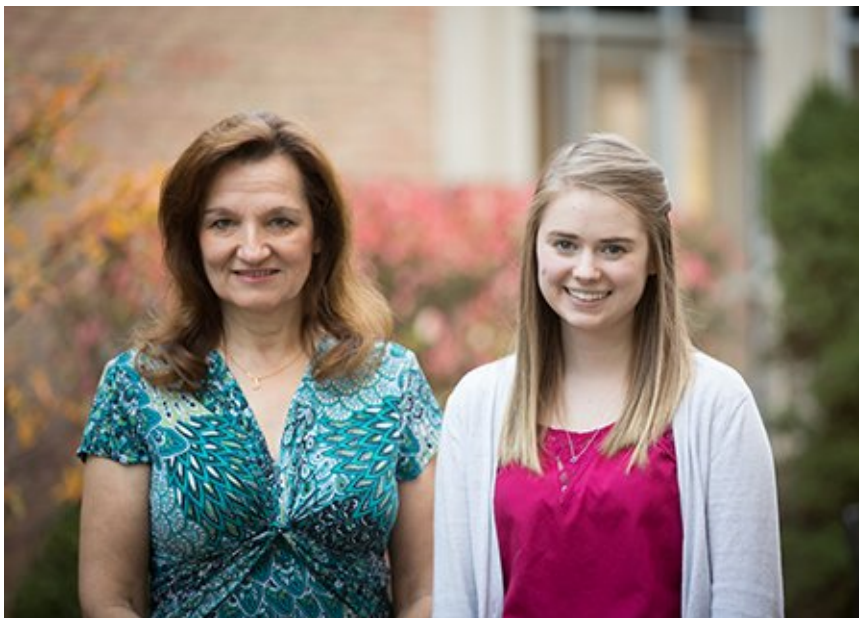

## Two OU students award winners at Sigma Xi Research Conference

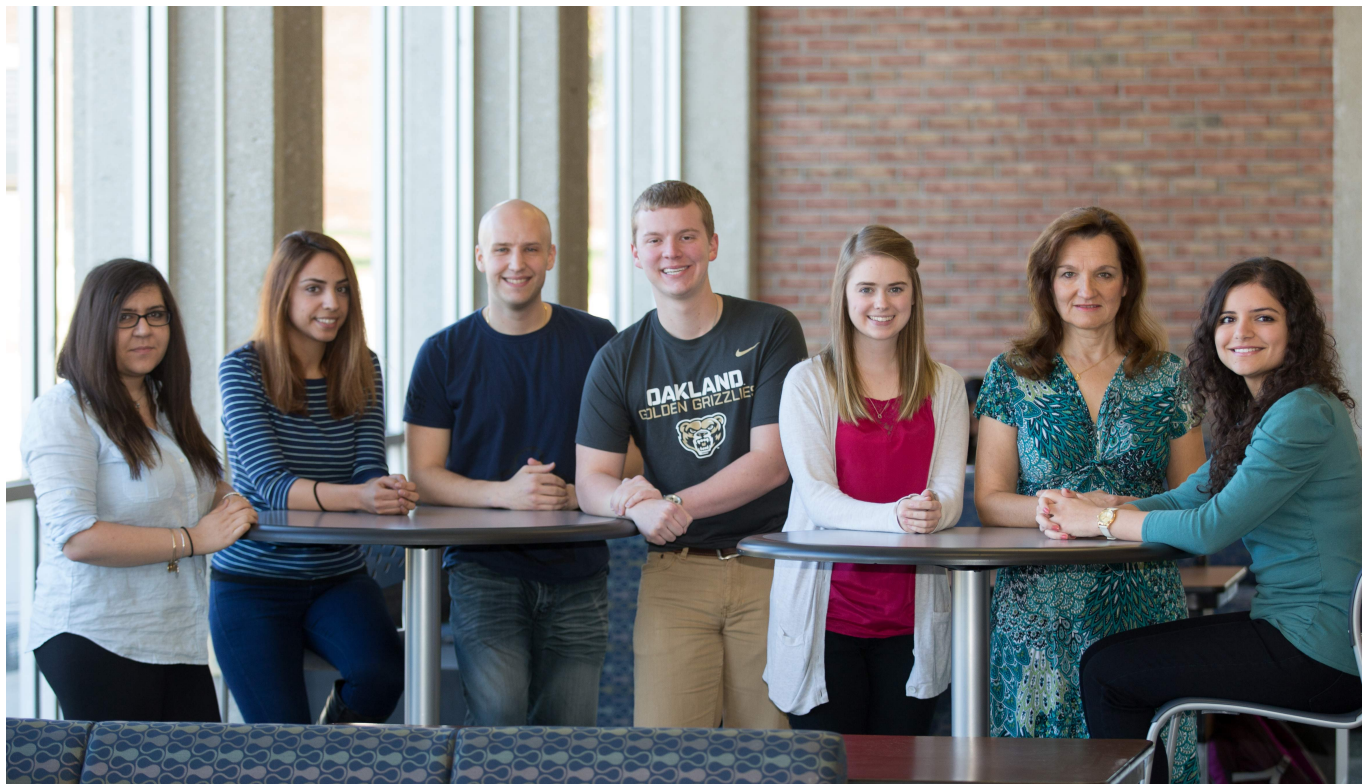
Two OU students took home awards at **Sigma Xi Student Research Conference**.
