The event will be presented by Dr. Virginia Uhley, assistant professor of foundational medical studies at Oakland University William Beaumont School of Medicine.

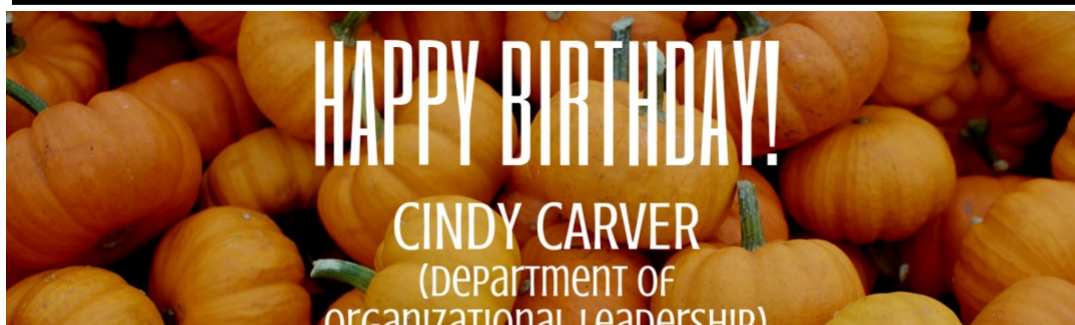

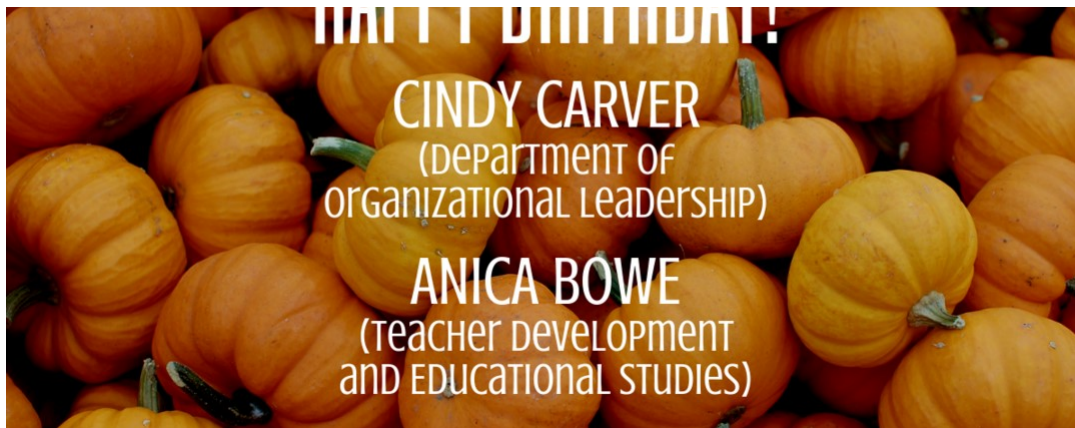
This presentation is designed for parents, educators and other professionals working with individuals on the Autism Spectrum. There is no cost to attend.
