Mr. Varner discussed the letter from Senor Alfonso Ocampo Londono of Universidad Del Valle regarding the exchange of students and faculty. Several ideas were proposed to the Chancellor which he will take under advisement.

Mr. Corona explained again the Recommended Student Rate Adjustment Plan and discussed the cost analysis information prepared earlier. It was agreed that the minimum starting rate for student employees will be raised from \$.95 per hour to \$1.00 per hour. In addition, to assure equitable payment for current student employees, the following increases are to be granted effective January 6, 1964:

- A. Students currently earning \$.95 per hour will be paid \$1.00 per hour.
- B. Students currently earning \$1.00 per hour will be paid \$1.05 per hour.
- C. Students currently earning \$1.05 per hour will be paid \$1.10 per hour.

At the present time, student pay rates in excess of \$1.05 per hour require the approval of this office. Beginning January 6, 1964, this maximum limitation will be \$1.15 per hour and any rate in excess of this amount will require the approval of the personnel office.
